The Smithtown Sheriff Volunteers are a team of trained citizen volunteers who assist Deputies with non-enforcement duties and value added services that allow Deputies to focus on crime reduction.

Members do not take enforcement action, carry weapons, or make arrests.

Sheriff volunteers will receive training in but not limited to:

- Orientation and Organization
- Crime Prevention
- CPR and First Aid
- Introduction to Law
- Driver Awareness
- Patrol Procedures
- Traffic Control
- Radio Communications
- Basic Report Writing

Volunteers also complete one ride-along with a Patrol Officer as part of the training program.
